

FROSH DAY AT RENO

As part our attempt to improve our services to incoming freshmen and make the transition smoother from 8th grade, we would like to invite those students who are zoned for Reno High School to come over for an all-day registration/orientation event. This would take place during the last week of March (the 24th) and will require chaperones from the visiting schools to attend with the students.

Students will be broken up into groups of 30-35 and will be issued a colored wristband. Each group will then rotate to 7 different "stations" during the school day. Lunch will be provided.

The schedule will look something like this:

Students unload at 7:50 am near the small gym

8:00 - 8:40 (Every group at Station 1)

8:40 - 9:20

9:20 - 10:00

10:00 - 10:40

10:40 - 11:20

11:20 - 12:05

12:05 - 12:30 - Lunch in small gym

12:30 - 1:10

1:10 - 1:40

Students reload their buses at 1:40 for return trip to their school.

Schedule for Stations

Students will be assigned to buses and a colored wrist band will be placed on their wrists by our staff as they exit the bus at Reno High (students will not self-select their groups). Students are then sorted into their groups and will, from that point on, be under the guidance of their group leader (a Reno High staff member). We ask that at least one chaperone from Swope or Clayton be with each group. We will provide AAA parent chaperones as well. Students will be provided lunch as well as several snack/drink breaks throughout the day.

Stations:

- 1- Group Leader - all students will begin by meeting with their group leader. They will explain the day's events and get a roster of students in their group.
- 2 - Counselors (Library) - students will meet with counselors and turn in their registration forms. Information will be provided about the library and computer lab as well.
- 3 - Student Interaction (IA building) - incoming students will have a chance to meet with current students and hear their success/non-success stories. There will be time for Q and A
- 4 - Inside Tour (begins in small gym) -Students will be taken on a tour of most of the inside of Reno High. This tour will be lead by teachers from our staff.
- 5 - IDs/Athletics/Frosh Visit (Cafeteria) -Students will have their ID pictures taken and receive information/packets about athletics and student activities. Info will be provided about physicals, summer conditioning and tryouts.
- 6 - Outside Tour (begins in small gym) -Students will be taken on a tour of our GB halls, IA building, and athletic areas. In addition, students will receive information on our lunch/off-campus policies and expectations.
- 7- Frosh Video (Theater) -Students will watch a video (starring Reno High staff) which will give them valuable information on how to get through their first weeks as a freshman at Reno High. This will be presented by RHS Leadership students and there will be time for questions and answers.
- 8 - Frosh Success (Alumni Center) - students will be given a few minutes to explore the Alumni Center and receive some important information from Mr. Sullivan and Mrs. Feroah on being successful during their frosh year.
